"So, it's again time for the third annual BIG 94.5 Country Topeka PRCA Rodeo this Friday and Saturday evenings, Aug. 22 and 23," at the North Topeka Saddle Club arena, right at the north edge of Topeka," announced Rusty Walker, world renowned Morning Show personality-host on The BIG 94.5 Country, and rodeo committee member.

"Friday, Aug. 22, is Patriot Night, sponsored by R Bar B of Topeka. American flags will be given out to the first 600 through the gate. Each flag is to be numbered, and one lucky rodeo fan will win a new pair of boots from R Bar B," Walker said. "Saturday, Aug.

23, has been designated as Tough Enough To Wear Pink Night for breast cancer awareness.

"The BIG 94.5 Country's \$10,000 Golden Horseshoe Toss is at Saturday's performance," Walker continued. "Qualified contestants will have a chance to throw a competition size horseshoe in the rodeo arena. A ringer will win them \$10,000."
