Demand was strong at the Ladies Nite 8 Lowline Sale in the Bittersweet West Sale facility on the Adcock Ranch at Hiawatha, J.R. Adcock reported.

Advertised on 580 WIBW, the auction topped when flush rights to NCS Lady CD sold for \$5,000 to Ninth Avenue Cattle Company, Voltaire, N.D. A black yearling heifer brought \$4,000 from Wintergreen Farms, Waverly, Ohio.

Salers breeding females averaged \$2,621, and one Salers bull sold for \$2,500. Salers cross steers tallied \$1,900 each, and Salers club calf females netted \$1,483 apiece.
