Four Weekends of Rodeo Action Set By K-State Rodeo Club At Manhattan

Rodeo action is full steam ahead at Kansas State University, according to Brooke Wallace, publicity chair for the K-State Rodeo Club.

A full four-weekend slate of activities kicks off tomorrow at Manhattan with the Wildcat Ranch Rodeo Saturday, Jan 30, in the heated Weber Arena on the north end of the campus, according to Wallace.

Other events on tap for February are the Kansas State Iron Woman competition on Saturday, Feb. 6; the K-State Rodeo Club Bull Riding School, February 12-13, and annual highlight of the year, the K-State Rodeo, a National Intercollegiate Rodeo Association-sanctioned event drawing college cowboys and cowgirls from throughout the Central Plains Region, February 19, 20 and 21. All are at Weber Arena.

Jointly sponsored by the B Double M and the K-State Rodeo Club, the Wildcat Ranch Rodeo has advance entries from throughout the Midwest, and

competition is such that it has been reported "slack" will be run during the afternoon.

Advertised and promoted on 580 WIBW, The BIG 94.5 Country, and the Kansas Agriculture Network, the ranch rodeo's action is officially set to begin at 5:30, Saturday evening, with a Calcutta starting at 5:15.

Events are to include double mugging, double doctoring, trailer loading and wild cow milking.
